What happens when you arrive

- Meet and greet at Schools Registration Area for a general overview of tours available at both designated campus
 - Nambour Campus - Marquee just inside the gate near bus drop off
 - Mooloolaba Campus – Marquee located in Mountain Creek High School car park near bus drop off
- Students will be given a map of the campuses detailing the tours and times and where they need to go to join the tour of their choice.
- All tours are interactive and take approximately 1 hour to complete
- Students can spend time visiting the Apprenticeship/Traineeship Information booths to demystify "signing the contract" and how to get there
- Students will have an opportunity to make an appointment for a one on one consultation with our guidance counsellors or they can collect information brochures or ask questions from our Client Services Information Stand
- Students can get on line and register at our new industry support network portals
